This is a special bookbinding workshop in March (in addition to the twice yearly Calligraphy Workshops)

The class will be the whole week with Monique. Included in the cost of this retreat are: the workshops, meals (15), and five nights lodging. There is a pickup and/or drop-off at the Greensboro airport for a fee of \$25. Additional information and directions will be sent upon receipt of deposit.

We will do a simple suede leather binding in addition to a 2-3 board structure. This is an interesting technique that doesn't require fancy equipment and is a versatile technique that works on all kinds of books providing lots of possibilities for design and use of colored paper, leather, fabric or other material. The Students will learn how to sew a book, round it, cut the boards and put the binding together whether they use leather or paper or fabric (smooth and rather thin fabric like cotton). This technique can also be used for books or photo albums. If time allows Monique will show some onlay techniques and do some design on the books.

You should have in addition to the supply list:

Paper folded to form a book in sections. Each section should have two folios (if Arches text paper) or section of three or four folios if the paper is thin (Mohawk Superfine or the like). Each book can have 8 to 16 sections. A disbound book can also be used but the book should be disbound-(book is unsewn, clean and in sections before you come to class).

Students can work on a blank book and will be shown how to disbound a book and prepare it to be rebound so they can do it later at home.

Supply list: Bone folder, ruler, cutter and scalpel with blades #23. paring knife if available (there will be some available for sale at workshop), leather if you have some (Monique will bring some for sale), a pencil and book for notes, a mat on which to cut paper or leather, matboards, paper for end sheets (colored or marbled) PVA and paste (wheat or rice starch), brushes for glue and paste, and a jar for water (to put the brushes in water), rags to wipe the brushes and hands.
